

To ensure the health and safety of all personnel working for CleanCo the following information will assist you in preparing and accessing our sites.

1

While CleanCo encourages people to be vaccinated against COVID-19, there is currently no mandatory requirement to be vaccinated to work at CleanCo.

If this requirement changes due to Queensland Health Directives, or as a result of future risk assessment or consultation processes undertaken by CleanCo, we will advise you immediately.

If you are displaying symptoms, please contact your CleanCo representative, **stay home and get tested**. Only attend site following a negative PCR or Rapid Antigen Test and when you are symptom free.

If you become a confirmed positive (PCR or Rapid Antigen Test) or a close contact, please contact your CleanCo representative to discuss delays or changes to your initial engagement for work.

Where a QR Code is available on site you will be required to sign in using a personal mobile device.

Site specific access registers will also be maintained.

Each site will have a sign in process to follow which will include completion of a COVID-19 Health Screening Form and a temperature check.

To prevent the spread of COVID-19 at sites you will be required to comply with social distancing, mask and hygiene protocols as applicable.

These requirements may change in response to the current risk level so please check the individual site requirements with your CleanCo representative before commencing work.
